SUBJECT: BARBECUE GRILLS

REISSUED: September 2005

PURPOSE: To conform with the guidelines for barbecue use as have been established by local government authorities.

POLICY: In accordance with a letter, dated July 28, 2003 from the City of Northville Fire Department, the use of outside grills on the grounds of the Association will be limited and operated as follows:

- 1. The grill should be located in an open area, not on or under any combustible structure, at a safe distance from the building.
- 2. The grill must be placed on a non-combustible surface such as dirt, cement, asphalt or metal.
- 3. Be aware of wind conditions to prevent unnecessary smoke or odor travel to nearby residences.
- 4. Do not leave the grill unattended during cooking or while there are still hot coals remaining.
- 5. Always have a fire extinguisher nearby and accessible.
- 6. Keep young children away from the grill.
- 7. Barbecuing on balconies and inside garages is prohibited.

In addition, any plans for the installation of a permanently mounted grill must be submitted, in writing, to the Association for approval with a diagram showing the location of the installation.
